

### Maude Clifford Book Swap 2024

Does your child have a pile of books sitting in their room that they have already read? Do you wish you had the opportunity to exchange them for more exciting reading materials?

#### The Book Swap Is For You!

#### How it works:

On January 22 and 23 students may bring in any "gently used" books to their homeroom teacher. Students can bring in a maximum of 3 books and will be allowed to take home up to 3 books. We will gladly accept extra books if you choose to donate more than 3, but we are only allowing trades up to a maximum of 3. If a student is unable to bring a book(s) for donation, they have the option of purchasing up to 3 books for \$1.00 per book with all proceeds going to the Maude Clifford School Library to purchase new books for the school population. We will be unable to accept books after January 23rd.

Book Swap Day will be Wednesday, January 24th (January 25th for Kindergarten only). Students will be able to select any "gently used" books of their choice (up to 3) with their trades or money. Students from each homeroom will have a time slot to go to the Book Swap.

#### **Book Criteria:**

Please make choices carefully before bringing in books. We can only accept books under the following guidelines:

- Books must be appropriate for grades K-6
- Books must be in gentle used condition: cover on, no rips, tears, water damage, or bent edges
- · Books with coloring or writing in them will not be accepted
- Coloring books, activity books, and sticker books will not be accepted

Please note that the selection of books available will be based on books donated. We cannot ensure specific titles, genres, etc. If you have any questions, please contact your classroom teacher.
